## Graduating Student Survey Spring 2021

By the Office of Institutional Effectiveness

University of Houston Clear Lake

## Summary of the Survey

The purpose of the Graduating Student Survey is to determine the level of satisfaction of students with their recent higher education experience at the University of Houston-Clear Lake (UHCL). In addition, we solicit the student's opinions regarding which areas or issues need improvement to ensure that UHCL maintains the highest quality of instruction and support. Finally, the percentage of students who would recommend UHCL to family or friends is included in the UHCL progress card each year and is on the next page.

We conduct the Graduating Student Surveys in the fall, and spring semesters using Qualtrics, a cloud-based software often used to capture a user's experience. The Office of Institutional Effectiveness sent an invitation to all students who applied for graduation during the Spring 2021 semester to complete the survey on March 29. The survey was active through May 31, 2021. You'll find the data grouped by college, degree level, gender, ethnicity, and program. The following pages summarize data collected in the Graduating Student Survey Spring 2021 by UHCL as a whole and the individual schools.

## Quick points for UHCL Demographics

## Respondents:

A total of 1,179 UHCL graduating students were invited to participate. During this collection period, 330 students started the survey. If students exited the survey session before completing it, they had 72 hours to return and complete the survey and 21
students did not complete the survey.
However, their responses are included in the results. The median completion time was about 7 minutes.
