

Co-op / Internships / Eligibility requirements

Both Cooperative Education and School of Business internships provide students with invaluable learning experiences within actual work environments in their fields of study.

This integration of classroom studies with work experience helps develop professional skills and provides the student with employment experience to cite on his/her resume. All co-op and some internships are paid positions. Internships must be completed PRIOR to graduation.

Co-op Undergraduate Eligibility Requirements

- Acceptance into a program in the School of Business
- Signed and approved candidate plan of study
- Completion of lower level requirements
- Completion of 12 credit hours at UHCL
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above

Co-op Graduate Eligibility Requirements

- Acceptance into a program in the School of Business
- Signed and approved candidate plan of study
- Completion of all foundation courses
- Completion of 9 credit hours at UHCL
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above

Co-ops are coordinated through Career Services

Internship Undergraduate Eligibility Requirements

- Acceptance into a program in the School of Business
- Signed and approved candidate plan of study
- Completion of all lower level requirements
- Completion of 12 semester hours at UHCL
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above

Internship Graduate Eligibility Requirements

- Acceptance into a program in the School of Business
- Signed and approved candidate plan of study
- Completion of all foundation courses
- Completion of 9 semester hours at UHCL
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above

Internships are coordinated by School of Business faculty.
