

Transfer course credits / Transfer tips

Transfer credits (Lower level)

As an upper level institution, UHCL does not teach freshman or sophomore courses but does recognize a specific number of lower level courses from other institutions. Thus, the required 21 hours of School of Business foundation courses must be satisfied with transfer credits from other institutions.

Transfer course Credits (Upper level)

Upper-level credit earned more than seven years prior to the semester the Candidate Plan of Study is signed may not be counted toward degree requirements without approval from the School of Business Office of Academic Advising. Academic advisors research the suitability of transfer upper level coursework to the student's current degree requirements. It is very helpful when students can provide advisors with course syllabi (from the year the courses were taken) to aid in this evaluation.

Transfer Tips

- A minimum of 60 lower level hours (freshman and sophomore) and 60 upper level hours (junior and senior) are required for a bachelor's degree from the School of Business.
- Lower level credits do not expire. However, upper level hours earned more than seven years prior to enrollment at UHCL may not be used toward a student's degree without approval from the Office of Academic Advising.
- English Composition I and II must be grades of "C-" or better to satisfy the core curriculum requirement.
- A total of 54 hours of "C" or better courses are required to transfer to UHCL.
- If transferring from a four-year institution, 30 hours of upper level courses, including a minimum of 12 hours in the major, must be completed at UHCL.
- No upper level credit is granted for correspondence, CLEP or extension work.
