### Step A for International Students

1. Obtain a copy of the sponsorship affidavit from the [UHCL Admissions Office](#).
2. Request a letter from your sponsor indicating why he/she cannot provide the necessary support to you. The letter must be mailed directly from the sponsor to our office. The letter should include:
  - a. Your name
  - b. Your student ID number
  - c. Why your sponsor cannot continue to support you. The sponsor must be specific as to what changes have occurred that prohibit continued financial sponsorship.
  - d. The letter must be notarized and must be in English or have an English translation included with it.

### Step B for Undocumented Students

1. Obtain a copy of the 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid.
2. Complete the form according to instructions. If your parents will not file a US income tax return, answer question 76 as "Will not file" and leave questions 77 through 79 blank. Complete questions 76 through 83. Be sure to report amounts in U.S. dollars if your parents' income is earned in another currency.
3. Complete the rest of the form as instructed. One parent must sign.
4. Return the completed form to the Office of Student Financial Aid.
