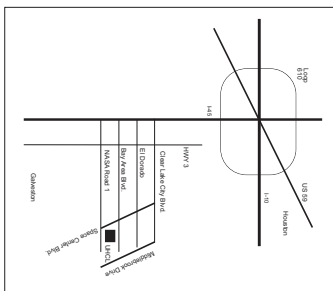

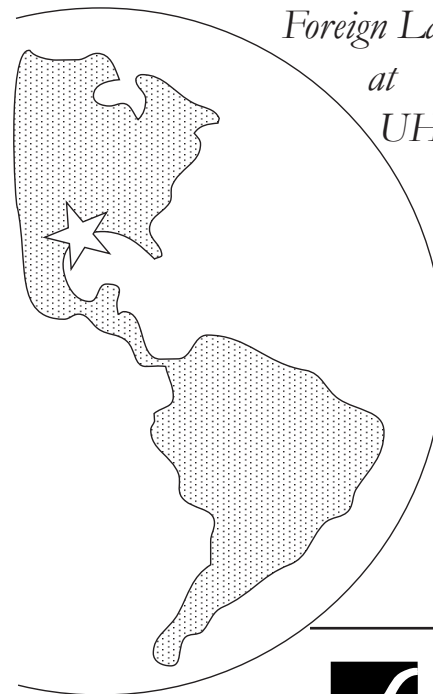

Instruction

The emphasis is on the development of conversational skills, and the method is totally oral. You will be speaking in the desired language from the first class meeting, and the grammar is learned while practicing oral drills with other students. These dialogues contain the practical vocabulary necessary for everyday situations encountered abroad. The oral method will encourage you to think in the language quicker than in traditional methods of language teaching.

Class Environment

Classes are small, with a minimum of five students. Small classes mean that you will receive personal attention from the teacher, and you will be able to form friendships with others in a comfortable, stress-free atmosphere. Students come from all parts of the Bay Area and represent all age groups and professions.

English Enhancement

The English Enhancement Program is designed specifically to assist you, the foreign professional in the development of conversational skills in English. If you have already studied the grammatical principles of the English language, yet are still unable to converse fluently, then UHCL is where you want to be. The emphasis in the classroom is on the following aspects of the spoken language:

- Correction of pronunciation
- Intonation
- Common English speech patterns
- Vocabulary building
- Idiomatic usage

Instructors

The teachers all possess native fluency, advanced degrees in the language, and experience in teaching the oral method.

Textbooks and Audio Materials

Tuition fees do not include books and audio materials are available through Web CT. Textbooks are available in the University Bookstore.

Registration

You may register for a foreign language by: 1) clipping the attached form and enclosing a check payable to UH-Clear Lake; 2) online at our secure website, www.uhcl.edu/fl; 3) in person at the foreign language office in the Bayou Building. Fees are payable in advance for the entire session. Fees are not refundable except to students who withdraw before the first class meeting, (\$30 will be deducted from refund checks), or a credit will be given for the next session. Parking permits may be obtained from the University Police for UH-Clear Lake Lot D.
