


Academic Search Complete

Academic Search Complete through TexShare indexes and abstracts articles from more than 10,100 journals (plus monographs, reports, and conference proceedings) in the social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, engineering, language and linguistics, arts and literature, medical sciences, ethnic studies, and more. Selected full text is provided for over 6,100 journals (over 5,100 of which are peer-reviewed). Coverage dates from the 1880's and varies by journal. Updated daily.

STARTING & SEARCHING ACADEMIC SEARCH COMPLETE

From the library's World Wide Web homepage (<http://www.uhcl.edu/library>), click on **Databases A-Z**. In the alphabetical list of databases by name, click on the **Academic Search Complete** hyperlink.

Advanced Search with Boolean/phrase search mode is the default search method. See sample search form below.



Enter search terms. Connect multiple terms with a Boolean operator (AND, OR, NOT).

Help menu

If desired, specify a field (Author, Title, Subject Terms, Journal Name, etc.) for some or all of your search terms. Expand a search if needed by looking for some terms in the All Text (i.e., full text) field.

Caution: Using the Full Text limiter will exclude full text articles available via Article Linker.

Other publication types include Educational and Health reports. Primary source document includes selected U.S. Supreme Court cases, speeches, and American history documents.

Other document types include case study, editorial, interview, letter, literary criticism, speech, etc.

Tips: Enter Boolean operators, proximity operators, or truncation symbols directly into the search box.

and	children and violence	narrows the results by finding both terms in the same record
or	college or university	broadens the results by finding either or both terms
not	martin luther not king	narrows the results by finding <i>Martin Luther</i> but not <i>Martin Luther King, Jr.</i>
w	cloning w 5 human	finds <i>cloning</i> within 5 words of <i>human</i> , e.g., <i>cloning of a human being</i> , in that order
n	cloning n 3 human	finds <i>cloning</i> within 3 words of <i>human</i> , in any order
?	wom? n	single-character wildcard that broadens the results by finding <i>woman</i> or <i>women</i>
*	ethic*	multi-character wildcard that broadens the results by finding <i>ethic</i> , <i>ethics</i> , <i>ethically</i> , etc.

Publications | Subject Terms | Cited References | More ▾

- Use **Publications** to find whether a journal is indexed in the database, its peer-review status, dates of coverage, full text availability, etc.
- Use **Subject Terms** to identify and select official thesaurus terms, which may improve your search results. You also can identify thesaurus terms from the suggestions that appear to the left of a search results list or by viewing a full citation record.
- When you already have a good article on your topic, search **Cited References** to find other articles that have cited it.
- Use **Images** (under **More**) to find pictures of people, places, and things.
- Use **Indexes** (under **More**) to browse entries for and search specific fields (*author, author-supplied keywords, geographic terms, etc.*)

VIEWING & WORKING WITH RECORDS

Click the arrow to show or hide any limiter category.

If desired, narrow your results with author-supplied keywords or with official subject thesaurus terms.

Click the *Article Linker* button or **Check for possible full text to see whether full text is available from another source. See also **Article & Book Requests** on the library homepage for document delivery options.**

To see if UHCL owns the journal in paper copy or microfilm and where it's located in the library, click **Search the Neumann Library Catalog.**

Click **Add to folder and then **Folder View** when ready.**

Leads to all limiters.

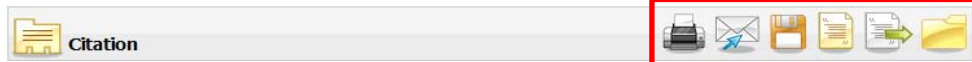
