


# American Periodical Series Online

**American Periodical Series Online** contains digitized images of more than 1,100 American magazines and journals that began publishing between 1741 and 1900. Derived from the acclaimed *American Periodical Series* microfilm collection, **APS Online** includes local, regional, and national special interest and general magazines, literary, cultural, and professional journals, children's and women's magazines, and many other historically significant periodicals. Complete issues, including advertisements, are included and provide historical evidence found in the published recorded observations of the times.

## STARTING & SEARCHING APS ONLINE

From the library's World Wide Web homepage (<http://www.uhcl.edu/library>), click on **Databases A-Z**. In the alphabetical list of databases by name, click on the **American Periodical Series Online** hyperlink.

At the **APS Online** opening screen, click **Search for Articles**. Advanced Search is the default search method. See sample search form below.

- Right Box:** If desired, select a field (Abstract, Author, Document title, etc.) for some or all of your search terms.
- Bottom Left Box:** Click More Search Options for additional limiters and choices.
- Bottom Right Box:** Document types include article, birth notice, classified ad, obituary, review, etc.
- Bottom Center Box:** Results can be sorted by oldest (historical) first, most recent first, or most relevant first.

**Tips:** Enter Boolean operators, proximity operators, and truncation symbols directly into the search box.

<b>and</b>	anti-slavery <b>and</b> convention	narrows the results by finding both terms in the same record
<b>or</b>	death <b>or</b> demise	broadens the results by finding either or both terms
<b>w/3</b>	lincoln <b>w/3</b> douglas	finds <i>Lincoln</i> within 3 words of <i>Douglas</i> , in any order
<b>?</b>	wom?n	single-character wildcard that finds <i>woman</i> or <i>women</i>
	educat??	finds <i>educated</i> or <i>educator</i> , but not <i>educate</i> , <i>education</i> , etc.
<b>*</b>	sex*	multi-character wildcard that finds <i>sex</i> , <i>sexes</i> , <i>sexual</i> , <i>sexuality</i> , etc.
<b>“ ”</b>	“farm tenancy commission”	finds the exact phrase <i>Farm Tenancy Commission</i> (quotes are needed only for phrases of 3 or more words)

Choose the **Publications** tab to identify periodicals with a particular subject focus, editor, publisher, or place of publication.
