Kraus Curriculum Development Library (KCDL) indexes over 7,500 documents with 4,000 in full text. Records include curricula, frameworks, and standards. It brings together educational objectives, content, instructional strategies, and evaluative techniques for all subjects covered in PreK-12 and Adult Basic Education. Sources include publications of Departments of Education from most states. Lesson plans are included as well. Updated monthly.

STARTING & SEARCHING KCDL

From the library's World Wide Web homepage (<http://www.uhcl.edu/library>), click on **Databases A-Z**. In the alphabetical list of **Databases by Name**, click on the **Kraus Curriculum Development Library** hyperlink.

Advanced Search is the default search method. See sample search form below.

1 **Advanced Search**

To select multiple non-consecutive terms within a given field, hold down the CTRL key, and then click each term you want to select.

To select multiple consecutive terms within a given field, click on the first term, hold down the SHIFT key, and then click the last term you want to select.

Search Clear Search

Select a keyword for the title of the curriculum or the summarization.

Select logical operator **AND, OR, or AND NOT.**

Choose from 15 subject clusters or student groups.

Choose a general or specific subject from the drop-down list.

Select desired term from 20 Educational Content choices.

Select the Grade Level from *PreK* to *Twelfth* or *Adult*.
Note: To choose multiple years, hold down CTRL key and click grade levels desired.

You may search for a curriculum listing from a specific school district, state department of education, special projects from universities, etc.

Only full text documents are available online. Check library catalog for others.

When ready, click **Search**.

Select Publication Year for documents published by issuing agency during a specific year.

To search for curricula that were included in a specific edition of KCDL, use the KCDL Edition field.
Note: Documents from the 20th edition forward are available online as PDFs and/or HTML files.

Tips: Enter Boolean operators, truncation symbols, or quotations into the *Title/Annotation* search box:

and	Texas and history	narrows the results by finding both words in the same record
or	college or university	broadens the results by finding records containing either or both terms
*	comput*	broadens the results by finding <i>computer</i> , <i>computers</i> , <i>computing</i> , <i>computation</i> , etc.
“”	“character education”	finds it as a phrase in the record
