Data files used were: uhcbgraduation along with an OIE query merged to the uhcbcbm009 tables titled PEGGY_GRADUATION_CBM009TABLE. If variance exists when comparing these figures to other previously published reports, it is important to note that these data may follow a different methodology. Totals by school and classification have all been verified with actual certified THECB reports and the number of terms to complete degree were verified for accuracy by sampling individual student records and asking the UH CB programmer to verify variable - these data will differ from previously published reports. 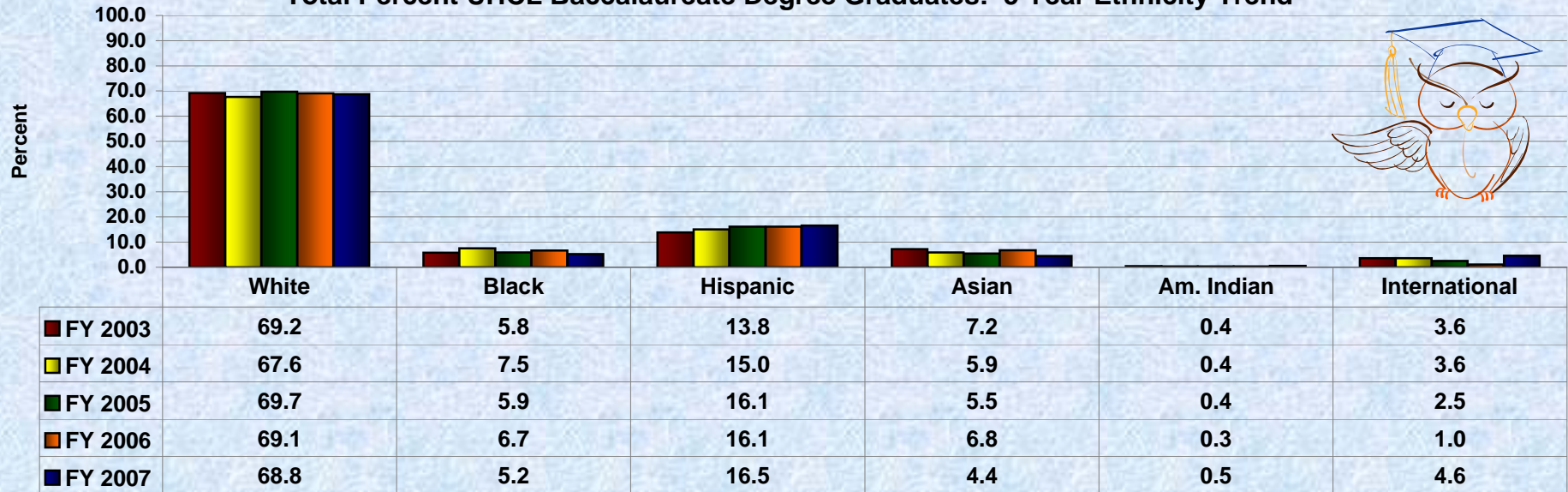

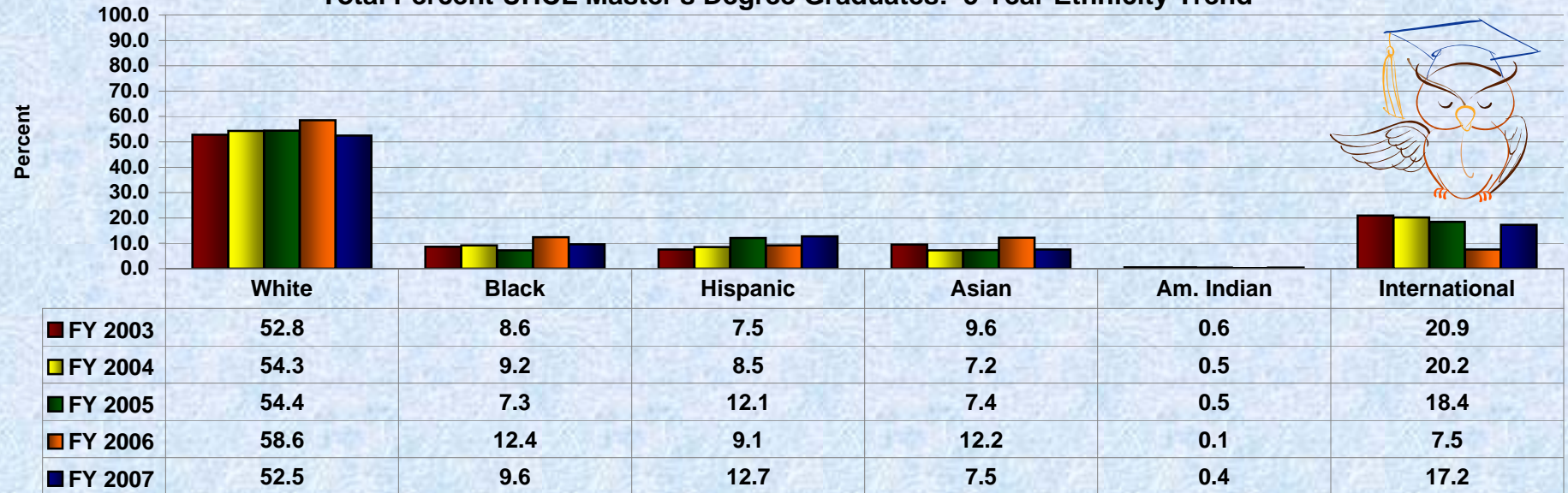
