3M INDUSTRIAL HYGIENE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- **Applicants must be currently enrolled in, or accepted into, a college or university industrial hygiene program.**
- **Applicants must have at least one year remaining in their studies.**
- **Applicants must prepare a one-page cover letter describing their accomplishments and career goals.**
- **An official graduate school transcript including grade point average must be included with applications. Enclosing an official undergraduate transcript is also advised.**
- **Two letters of recommendation, one preferably from a certified industrial hygienist, must be included with the application.**
- **Scholarship recipients, if available, will travel to the American Industrial Hygiene Conference and Exposition (AIHCE), June 1-3, Toronto, Ontario, Canada. 3M will provide travel and lodging arrangements for the scholarship recipients.**
- **Recipients must be able to verify proper use of scholarship funds and AIHCE expenses.**

Winners will be chosen based on academic performance and professional contribution. Special consideration will be given to graduate students and to those applicants who have relevant work experience and professional career goals. Members of the selection committee will verify the accuracy of all information. Their decision will be final.

2. **Educational Background:** A list of relevant information in chronological order, most current first. Include name of school and highest degree attained, if any, and years of attendance. Please include a copy of your current transcripts.
3. **Work Experience:** A short description of work experience that relates to industrial hygiene or worker safety.
4. **Honors:** A list as complete as you believe necessary.
5. **Association activities:** A list that includes the dates of membership, offices held, and committees on which you have served, in national, state, and local associations.

Letters of recommendation: Provide letters from two sources. Be certain to include addresses and phone numbers. If possible, one should be from an industrial hygienist.
