

# INTERN SCHOLARSHIPS

*The Intern Scholarship Program helps to reduce financial barriers for students participating in unpaid, credit-based internships within their field of study.*

## About the Scholarship

The Intern Scholarship Program aims to increase participation in experiential learning opportunities that help students achieve academic and professional success.

- Students with financial need who are participating in unpaid internships for academic credit are encouraged to apply for funding.
- This is a selective scholarship and the amount of funds is limited; therefore, not all applicants will be selected to receive funding.
- Preference for students with demonstrated financial need based upon the FAFSA or TASEFA application.
- The number of awards and dollar amounts will be based on available funds and demonstrated student interest and need.

## Eligibility



Open to any student enrolled in a UHCL Degree Plan with credit-based courses related to internships, co-ops, pre-service and clinical practicums



Meet academic prerequisites and receive internship experience approval of faculty adviser, program director and/or associate dean



Must be enrolled in a credit-based course related to internships, co-ops, pre-service and clinical practicums

## Up to \$1,300 Per Award

Recipients receive financial support in the form of a one-time institutional award of up to \$1,300. Award open to Fall, Spring, and Summer internships.
